The report shall include, but not be limited to the number of cumulative days each prisoner was confined to the following locations by correctional facility, race, security classification, security level, race and Earliest Release Date (ERD): ~~in administrative segregation and, of~~

~~those, the number who at any time during the current or prior prison term were diagnosed with serious~~

~~mental illness or have a developmental disorder and the number of days each of the prisoners with~~

~~serious mental illness or a developmental disorder have been confined to administrative segregation.~~

- (a) administrative segregation
- (b) temporary segregation
- (c) punitive segregation
- (d) in-patient mental health, broken down by program
- (e) close observation
- (f) adaptive skills residential program
- (h) protective custody

(2) The department shall report the number of prisoners assigned to one of these special housing units, cells, or designations who, at any time during the current or prior prison term, were diagnosed with serious mental illness or have a developmental disorder.

(3) The department shall report quarterly (**bi-annual?**) the number of individuals held on Notice of Intent Status(NOI) and/or Security Threat Group (STG) by correctional facility, the cumulative days held in this status by race, security classification, security level, SMI or disability and Earliest Release Date (ERD).

Rep. O'Neal put the following in the current boilerplate:

Sec. 714. Report on Restricted Visiting Privileges – NEW

Requires MDOC to report on the number of prisoners that lose visiting privileges, number of prisoners that apply to have visiting privileges restored, number of prisoners that have had visiting privileges restored, and number of prisoners that have had visiting restrictions extended.
